To our valued customers,

Total imports of steel have fallen by 40% since Q1 2025. Tariffs and geopolitical uncertainty have caused a reduction of 900,000 tons per month in supply in the domestic market. This has caused significant pressure on domestic steel producers to fill the void resulting in extended lead times and higher pricing.

Given these recent developments, we are implementing a price increase of **9%** on IMPACT buildings.

We will continue to keep you apprised of any information related to steel costs.

Your program will automatically update pricing on Monday, February 23rd, 2026.
